TRAFFIC SIGNAL SERVICE

EFFECTIVE DATE: April 10, 2007

AVAILABILITY

This schedule will be available for electric service supplied for the illumination of traffic signals installed along public and private highways within the service area of the Cooperative prior to April 10, 2007. (Consumers connected on or after April 10, 2007 will receive service under Schedule GS23.)

INSTALLATION

The cooperative, for each signal or group of signals operating from one controller, will make its connection to the consumer's service wire at the top of the pole, on which the controller is installed or other convenient point, as mutually agreed. Consumer will furnish, install, and maintain all service wires, fixtures, and other necessary equipment, including lamps and lamp renewals for the installation and operation of all traffic signals.

TYPE OF SERVICE

The service type under this schedule is 60-hertz, single-phase, two-wire, 120 volts nominal.

DEFINITION

Lamps burning at one time: This means all lamps that are controlled by a single controller, which are burning at a given point of time.

MONTHLY RATE

16 hours of operating service — 6.160 ¢ per month per watt of lamps burning at one time.

24 hours operating service — 7.090 ¢ per month per watt of lamps burning at one time.

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGE

The minimum monthly charge under this schedule shall be \$ 18.00.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills under this schedule are net and are due when rendered. Bills are past due based on the following schedule:
